All respondents have internet access at home. 6% do not have a personal laptop readily available to them at home and 16% use the **Chromebook** provided by the school. 71% bring and use an Apple laptop to school. This data shows that there is a small percentage of people who rely on the Chromebooks. **19% are** unable to download applications on their **laptop**. Students who used Chromebooks are unable to download applications.
